Clinical Social Worker- Fee for Service

Qualifications: Currently licensed as RN by the New York State Education Department. Clean valid NY State Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Outreach Services

Assistant Case Manager

Location: *Field work- location varies*

Job Function: Assist Case Managers by providing selected services to ICM clients.

Qualifications: High School Diploma or Equivalent. Individual **must** have personal experience with a mental health condition. Peer Certification preferred. Clean valid NYS Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check and all necessary clearances from the Justice Center.

Respite Plus Workers- Part-time

Location: *Field work- location varies*

Job Function: Provide Respite care to individuals with mental illness in order to increase their independent living skills and to provide time off for family members or caretakers.

Qualifications: High School Diploma. Experience in the Mental Health field. Good communication skills. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Volunteer Coordinator

Foster Grandparent Program- Senior Support Services

Location: *Medford*

Job Function: Responsible for the overall operation of the Foster Grandparent Program, including coordinating and supervising volunteer activities, providing volunteer training and orientation, overseeing program documentation, and data collection/reporting to comply with funding source requirements, in conjunction with the program manager.

Qualifications Bachelor's Degree preferred, or Associates Degree with a minimum of two years of experience in the social/human services field. Foster Grandparent Program

Senior Companion

Location: Patchogue

Job Function: Responsible for coordinating recruitment, training, placement and activities for volunteers and staff in the program. Provide support to volunteers through weekly in-service team meetings, community outreach and on-site trainings.

Qualifications: High School Diploma or equivalent experience in mental health, Clean N.Y. State Driver's license. Fingerprinting, NSOPR check, criminal record check and all clearances from the Justice Center

Outreach Counselor

POWER Program

Location: Patchogue

Job Function: Work with people who are homeless and recovering from mental illness and drug/alcohol abuse by providing outreach referrals, support and advocacy.

Qualifications: High School Diploma or equivalent. Personal experience in Mental Health and a clean N.Y. State driver's license. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Site Supervisor, Evening Drop-In

Location: Patchogue/Babylon - Part-time (4 - 16 hours per week)

Job Function: Responsible for the operation of the evening drop-in programs including, development of activities, supervision and training of staff, organize and completion of documentation, and crisis intervention. Assists in maintaining the cleanliness of the center

Qualifications: BA or equivalent experience in mental health. Supervisory experience preferred. Clean and valid NYS Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Care Coordinators (Various shifts within NYC & LI Region)

Location: Medford & Queens

Job Function: Provide care coordination and health promotion to individuals with severe mental illness and/or have 2 or more chronic health conditions. This will include linkage to behavioral, medical, residential, social, financial, and vocational resources; collateral contacts with both behavioral and medical treatment follow up with referral and treatment appointments, and education of health promotion and preventive care. The care manager will communicate with the treating clinicians to discuss enrollee's care needs, conflicting treatments, change in condition, etc. which may necessitate treatment change (i.e., written orders and/or prescriptions).

Qualifications: Minimum of a Bachelor's degree or a CASAC with at least 2 to 5 years of experience serving people with mental illness, developmental disabilities or alcoholism or substance abuse. Valid and clean NYS driver's license preferred. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.



Care Coordinator - Health Homes Serving Children

Location: *Queens*

Job Function: Provide care coordination and health promotion that is family-and-youth driven, supports a system of care that builds upon the strengths of the child and family. Service individuals aged 21 and under with *Serious Emotional Disturbance, Complex Trauma, and/or 2 or more chronic health conditions* to integrate the delivery of physical and behavioral health services, identify and address needs early to prevent escalation and longer term need for higher end services, maintain child in community and at home with support services. Collaborates with families, providers, and schools as well as oversees and coordinates access to all services (behavioral, medical health and social service supports) to assist individuals to stay healthy. Complete all required documentation according to standards and no later than 24 hours of service delivery.

Qualifications: Minimum of a Bachelor's degree with at least 2 years relevant experience; OR Registered Nurse with 2 years relevant experience; OR Master's Degree with 1 year relevant experience. Clean, valid NYS Driver's License preferred. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Residential Services

Case Managers: (Various positions available –Full- Time)

Location: *SSSH – Supportive Housing Team B, D & F (Queens, Bronx & Suffolk)*

Job Function: Provide case management services, housing supports and coordination of services to people with psychiatric disabilities living in scattered apartment settings.

Qualifications: High School Diploma and at least 3 years experience in mental health. BA in Human Services and 1 year experience preferred. Clean valid NY State Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Peer Specialists (Multiple positions available)

Location: *PT & FT position available at Team- B, ,D, E & F (Queens, Bronx & Suffolk)*

Job Function: Provide positive role model of community functioning, informal counseling and peer supports to others with psychiatric disabilities currently living in residential programs.

Qualifications: Some experience living in a community residence program for people with psychiatric disabilities or in independent living. Mastery of basic ADL skills, Ability and desire to assist others in mastery of independent living skills. Understanding of peer support self-help philosophy. Valid and clean NYS Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Overnight Rehabilitative Associates

Location: *W. Brentwood- IBR*

Job Function: Provide supportive counseling, restorative services, ADL Training, and crisis intervention to people with psychiatric disabilities in a licensed residential program.

Qualifications: BA in Human Services OR Two years' experience working with persons with psychiatric disabilities. Valid and clean NYS Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.



Relief Counselors (Multiple positions available)

Locations: *Glen Cove CR, Massapequa CR, & W. Brentwood*

Job Function: Provide supportive counseling, restorative services, ADL training, and crisis intervention to people with psychiatric disabilities in a licensed residential program.

Qualifications: High School Diploma and at least 1 year of experience working in a mental health setting, B.A. in Human Services and some experience with persons with psychiatric disabilities preferred. Valid and clean NYS Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Counselors: (Multiple positions available)

Location: *Glen Cove (Community Residence)*

Job Function: Provide supportive counseling, restorative services, and crisis intervention training in a licensed residential program providing transitional housing to people with psychiatric disabilities.

Qualifications: High School Diploma and 1 year of experience working in a mental health setting OR a Bachelor's Degree in Human Services. Clean valid NY State Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Rehabilitative Associate

Location: *W. Brentwood (IBR)*

Job Function: Provide supportive counseling, restorative services, and crisis intervention to people with psychiatric disabilities in a transitional licensed residential program.

Qualifications: BA in Human Services OR two years' experience working with persons with psychiatric disabilities. Clean valid NYS Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Health Office Rehabilitative Associate

Location: *W. Brentwood (Sunken Meadow)*

Job Function: Assist Program Supervisor in the daily operations of a licensed residential program providing transitional housing to people with psychiatric disabilities.

Qualifications: BA in Human Services plus 1 year experience working with persons with psychiatric disabilities OR High School Diploma and 3 years experience working with persons with psychiatric disabilities. Knowledge of residential services, substance abuse and psychiatric rehabilitation practice. Clean, valid NYS Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)

Location: *Sunken Meadow Residence, W. Brentwood*

Job Function: Provides health services including medication management as a member of a multidisciplinary residential team to people with psychiatric disabilities in a transitional licensed residential program.

Qualifications: Currently licensed as a Licensed Practical Nurse by the New York State Education Department. Valid and clean NYS Driver's License. Minimum of 1 year of experience at a treatment or rehabilitation setting. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.



Program Supervisor (SSSH- Team G- including NYC 1515)

Location: *Bronx*

Job Function: Supervise staff to ensure the smooth operation of Supportive Scattered Site Housing Programs serving people with psychiatric disabilities and/or substance use disorders. Assist the Program Manager in all aspects of program supervision, management and development.

Qualifications: Licensed Master's level Social Worker or other Master's level mental health profession with five years' experience in mental health and/or substance abuse, strong clinical and supervisory skills. Knowledge of residential services, evidence based practices and psychiatric rehabilitation practice. Clean, valid NY State Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, and an approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.

Program Supervisor (SSSH- Team F)

Location: *Queens*

Job Function: Supervise staff to ensure the smooth operation of Supportive Scattered Site Housing Programs serving people with psychiatric disabilities. Assist the Program Manager in all aspects of program supervision, management and development.

Qualifications: Master's Degree in Human Services with 1 year experience working with individuals with psychiatric disability or Bachelor's Degree with 3 years' experience working with individuals with psychiatric disabilities. Knowledge of residential services, substance abuse services, evidence based practices and psychiatric rehabilitation practice. Clean, valid NY State Driver's License. Fingerprinting, criminal record check, approval from NYS Office of Mental Health.
